The Community Grants Program has been developed to encourage, engage and support individuals and groups in the community to make a positive and ongoing contribution to the City's community wellbeing, economic prosperity, and environmental sustainability. It is a strategic investment tool, that enables Council to deliver on the priorities and vision as outlined in the Strategic Plan through mutual benefit for the community.

Community Partnership Grants of up to \$15,000 are available each year for incorporated not-for-profit groups based in Clarence and for groups based outside of the Clarence region for projects that bring significant benefits to the Clarence community. The total amount of funds available is \$30,000.

Community Partnership Grants support projects that align closely with Council's identified plans and endorsed activities and have the potential to build community capacity. Projects must have outcomes that continue to significantly benefit the Clarence community over the life of the project and beyond.
